



WHO IS ALICE®?

ALICE represents the **A**sset **L**imited, **I**ncome **C**onstrained, **E**mployed families and individuals who live and work in the Tri-County.




We all know ALICE. Many of us are ALICE, or have been ALICE. The ALICE population makes up our community's essential workforce in roles such as cashiers, servers, home nurses, truck drivers, educators and more.

Although employed with vital jobs that keep our communities running, ALICE workers don't earn enough to cover the rising costs of living, leaving individuals and families one emergency or unexpected expense away from a cycle of financial instability.

IN THE TRI-COUNTY

Nearly **132,000 households (39%)** live below the ALICE threshold.



-  **Federal Poverty Level** 4-person household: under \$30,000 annual income
-  **Estimated ALICE Survival Budget** 4-person household: \$87,000 annual income
-  **Above ALICE threshold** 4-person household: over \$87,000 annual income

HOW TRIDENT UNITED WAY IS HELPING

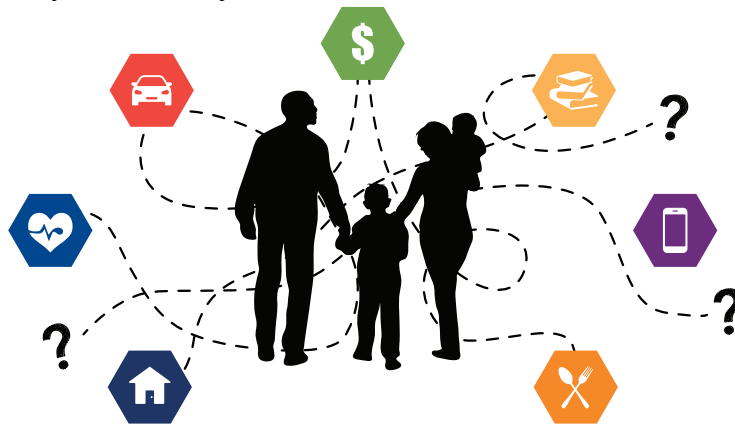
